Pathways of Technology Early College High School



Pathways in Technology Early College High Schools (P-TECH) are innovative, open-enrollment high schools.

P-TECH Programs:

- Enroll historically underserved students, targeting at-risk and economically disadvantaged
- Provide students grade 9 through 12 the opportunity to complete a course of study that combines high school and post-secondary courses
- Enable students to earn a high school diploma, along with an associate degree, Level 1 or Level 2 certificate, or industry-based certification within six years
- Offer age-appropriate, work-based learning opportunity in every grade level
- Allow students to gain work experience through an internship, apprenticeship or other job training program

Crowley ISD P-TECH Model



- The Crowley Academy of Aviation, Transportation, and Logistics (C-ATL)
- Five programs of study that offer dual credit opportunities
 (Aviation Maintenance, Distribution and Logistics, UAV/UAS, Aviation Flight, and Computer Programming)
 - Programs of study will provide entry points into a larger career
- CTE courses located at BRJ CTEC and core courses at home campus
- Opportunity to earn at least 1 of the following:
 - Level 1 / 2 Certification
 - Associates of Applied Science Degree
- Schedule Flexibility
- All students will earn an industry-based certification
 - FAA Part 107, OSHA, Warehouse Manager, Forklift, Power Plant, Programming

- Free College: Crowley ISD students enrolled in C-ATL receive their dual credit courses and books at no cost, saving about \$350 per class each semester.
- Careers that Pay:
 - The salary range for an airline pilot is \$52,000-\$120,000
 - Computer programmers and software developers have a salary range of \$57,000-\$120,000
- Jobs on the Way:
 - The projected growth rate for Logistics and Supply Chain Management career fields are expected to grow 30% from 2020-2030.
 - The DFW Metroplex has the second-highest employment rate for computer programmers in the nation.
