

Tardy Policy (Unexcused)*: A student is considered tardy to class if he/she is outside the classroom without a hall pass when the tardy bell rings. A student arriving tardy to class will not be admitted to class until the student produces a valid tardy slip from the attendance office. Student with excessive tardiness to a class will be referred to the Attendance Review Committee and appropriate Assistant Principal to discuss the student's tardiness.

1st tardy – warning

2nd tardy – warning

3rd tardy – before-school detention

4th tardy – before-school detention

5th tardy – before-school detention

6th tardy – Out-of-School-Suspension

7th tardy – Out-of-School-Suspension

8th tardy – Out-of-School-Suspension

9th tardy – Alternative School placement

*Failure to serve the assigned before-school-detention will result in after-school detention.

*Failure to serve after-school detention will result in out-of-school suspension.

*Tardies are cumulative. They will start over every six weeks.

*A student that is truant for a class in which that student has excessive tardies will receive the greater of the two consequences (tardies or truancy).
