<u>Tardy Policy (Unexcused)\*:</u> A student is considered tardy to class if he/she is outside the classroom without a hall pass when the tardy bell rings. A student arriving tardy to class will not be admitted to class until the student produces a valid tardy slip from the attendance office. Student with excessive tardiness to a class will be referred to the Attendance Review Committee and appropriate Assistant Principal to discuss the student's tardiness.

<sup>\*</sup>Failure to serve after-school detention will result in out-of-school suspension.

<sup>\*</sup>Tardies are cumulative. They will start over every six weeks.

<sup>\*</sup>A student that is truant for a class in which that student has excessive tardies will receive the greater of the two consequences (tardies or truancy).
